

The below charts are provided to help guide participants in understanding the rules for prohibited treatments or administration in the period prior to races/trials. The charts are assisted by visually showing the day on which certain treatments or administrations can occur.

- Green – Represents the last day the treatment/administration can occur prior to a race.
- Orange – Represents a day when treatment/administration cannot occur prior to a race day.
- Red – Represents race day when NO treatment/administration can occur.

1004AA(1) - the One Clear Day Rule. As of 12.01am the day prior to a race day, no administration of anything that could be ingested/injected/inhaled/topically applied to a horse is allowed. (This includes syringing or passive feeding of multivitamins or electrolytes) Only normal feeding practices are allowed. NB: Vitamin B12 contains cobalt.
